These stationary panels are lined and interlined, with contrast banding and trim on the leading edge. They have Italian Stringing to pull them back.

The sheer drapery is functional and is on a motorized rod.

The valance was made in two separate pieces, with the center jabot hiding the join.

The Austrian style swags are designed to have the fullness along the bottom only.

The chain cover was made and put on the chain before the chandelier was installed.

This table skirt is lined and interlined with an underskirt of table felt. I added a ruched bottom edge.

This client had French Country décor and loved the idea of an awning with a scallop flap for the window over her kitchen sink. I centered a stripe on the center of each scallop.

This is a shaped cornice with shaped banding and a balloon shade underneath. The balloon shade is motorized. The designer is Alisha Newman—IBD Studio



These flat shaped valances with horns have Roman shades underneath. By design, the arch shape is centered over each window. The seams are hidden underneath the horns. The designer is Alisha Newman—IBD Studio.
